Pakefield Urgent Works update

Further to our recent communications, please find an update on the Pakefield Urgent Works.

The barges are loaded with rock and ready to leave Cornwall. However, to enable the safest passage and delivery possible, five days of the right weather conditions are needed from Cornwall to the East Anglian coast. The forecast ahead for the next fortnight is not looking favourable. However, long-range forecasts are subject to change and we are monitoring the weather regularly, looking for positive changes. The barge will leave Cornwall as soon as the five day journey is possible.

The main site compound in All Saints Road car park has been set up and occupies approximately two thirds of the car park. However, the remainder of the car park is still open for use.

As a result of the delay in the delivery of the rock, heavy plant and machinery will not be arriving as scheduled. This means that those who park cars on the routes indicated in the previous information are free to do so until further updates are provided.
