

Corton Repairs and Maintenance

Corton, Suffolk

What are we updating you about?

Coastal Partnership East are the coastal management team for East Suffolk Council (ESC). We have appointed the Water Management Alliance (WMA) to complete repairs and maintenance of coastal protection assets along the Suffolk coast, which are owned or managed by ESC. WMA will be completing works at Corton as part of that contract.

Where is this work happening?

A map of where the work is taking place is on page 2 of this factsheet. The work will take place from Baker's Score, south along the promenade.

When are we doing the work?

Repair and maintenance work along the coastal defences is due to start from 3rd February 2025 and last approximately 2 weeks, allowing our maintenance contractor to maximise work around daily tides. All work is subject to safe working conditions i.e. tide and weather condition dependant.

What will we be doing?

WMA will be repairing and maintaining handrailing, signage, and the promenade. We will work hard to keep any inconvenience to a minimum and ask the public to please take note of the contractor's signage when work is happening.

Why are we doing this work?

This work will improve public safety and is an important part of ESC's commitment to ensure that the coastal assets they are responsible for are working effectively and are safe for the public, helping to protect our beautiful and important coastline economically and environmentally and for the enjoyment of communities and visitors for generations to come.

Undertaking regular targeted maintenance means that we can maximise the lifespan of coastal protection assets, ensuring that we make the most of every pound spent and achieve a better return on public investment. We are supporting the safeguarding of life and local economies by making sure that the Council's coastal assets are in the condition needed for continued protection.

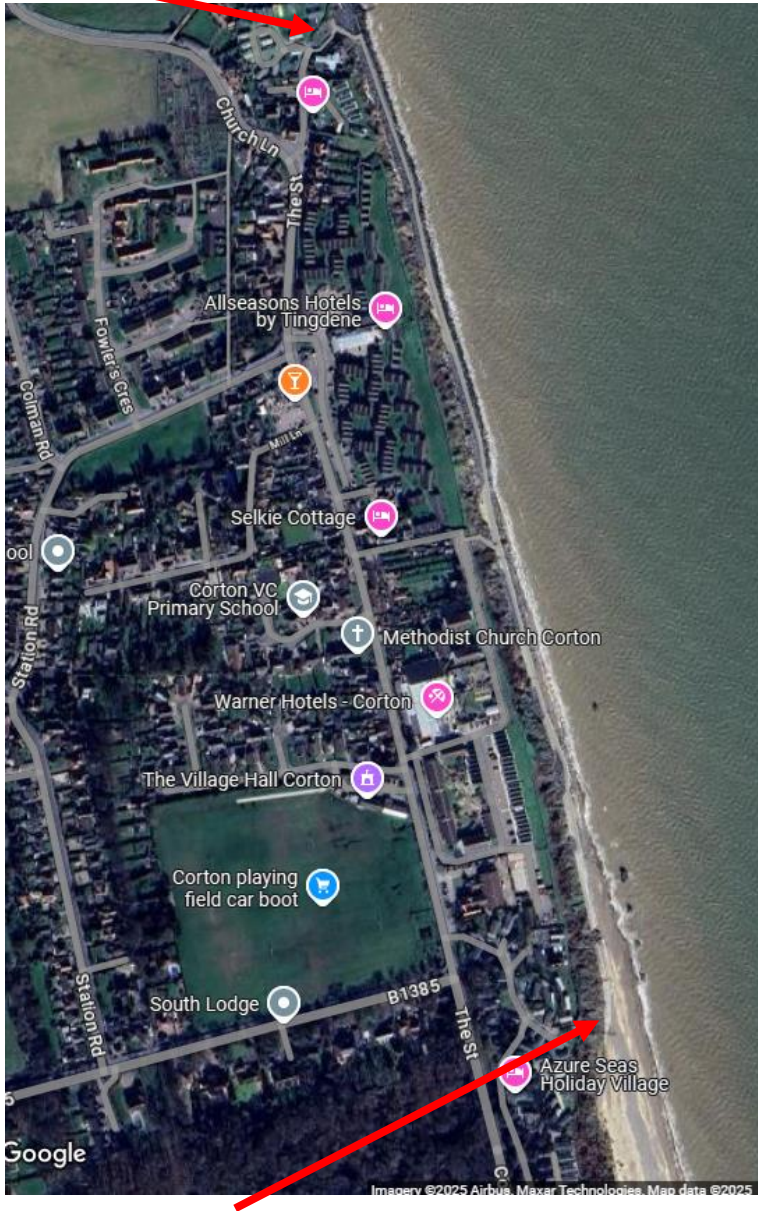
